Rules

GENERAL

- The Madison USBC Bowling Association Senior Championship is USBC Certified.
- All USBC rules not specified in this document are in effect.
- Courtesy to other bowlers is expected and will be enforced. Loud, rude, or unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated.
- Unofficial tournament standings, official tournament rules, and final prize lists will be available on the Madison USBC BA website.

- The Madison USBC Bowling Association Senior Championships are open to all certified members of the USBC and the Madison USBC Bowling Association in the current season ages 50 or older as of the opening squad date.
- MBA members who are also eligible for another association tournament must have bowled a minimum of nine games in an MBA certified league in the current season.
- Participation in the team event is unlimited, but no more than two players on any four person team may cash together more than once.
- Participation in minor events is limited to one time per bowler.
- Entry into the minor events requires participation in both doubles and singles.
- No more than two Professional Bowlers Association members of any classification may participate on any team or doubles team.

ENTRY

- Entries for each squad close the Wednesday prior to the scheduled squad date.
- The tournament may be extended if necessary.
- A \$50.00 non-refundable deposit is required with each entry. Deposits refunded only if none of the requested squads are available.

AVERAGES

- USBC Rule 319a is modified for this tournament. All bowlers use:
 - 1. 2014-15 COMPOSITE average of all USBC Red and/or White leagues, including leagues with less than 21 games bowled or,
 - 2. Current season single league average of 21 games if no (1.)
- All others bowl scratch.
- Tournament management reserves the right to assign averages per USBC Rule 319b when deemed appropriate.
- Other average adjustment rules in effect for this tournament include USBC Rules 319c and 319e
- USBC Rule 319d is waived.

TEAM DIVISIONS

- Division 1 Team averages 820 and above
- Division 2 Team averages 819 and below

DOUBLES DIVISIONS

- Division 1 Team averages 410 and above
- Division 2 Team averages 409 and below

SINGLES and ALL EVENTS DIVISIONS

- Division 1 Bowlers ages 50-54
- Division 2 Bowlers ages 55-59
- Division 3 Bowlers ages 60-64
- Division 4 Bowlers ages 65-69
- Division 5 Bowlers ages 70+
- Singles Divisions are determined by the entrants age as the opening squad date.

- Division One Team handicap is 100% of 920 less the team average.
- Division Two Team handicap is 100% of 820 less the team average.
- Division One Doubles handicap is 100% of 460 less the doubles average.
- Division Two Doubles handicap is 100% of 410 less the doubles average.
- Singles handicap is 100% of 230 less the individual average.
- All Events handicap is 100% of 230 less the individual average.
- All averages exceeding the handicap base of 230 will bowl scratch.

TITLES AND CHAMPIONSHIPS

- · The highest scratch scores bowled in each event (singles, doubles, team, and allevents) earn Madison USBC Bowling Association Tournament Titles.
- The highest net scores with handicap bowled in each event (singles, doubles, team, and all-events) earn Madison USBC Bowling Association Tournament Championships.
- Entry in the optional all events or scratch all-events prize pools is **NOT** required to earn a tournament Title or Championship.

OPTIONAL EVENTS

- All Events
 - 1. All Events scores are compiled by totaling series scores from the team, doubles, and singles events.
 - Handicap is added to the total of the actual scores in each event.
 - 3. The first score bowled in team event will count toward the All Events total.
 - Replacements for All Events must be made before either the original or replacement entrant has bowled in any event in the tournament.
 - 5. Any All Events score is given championship consideration.
 - Only an optional paid All Events entry will qualify a bowler for cash prizes.
 - 7. There will be no refunds given for any All Events entries.
- Optional Scratch
 - 1. The high scratch Team scores, Singles scores, Doubles scores, and All Events scores are compiled to determine prize winners.

- · Team, Doubles, and Singles
 - 1. \$17.00 per bowler, per event.
- 2. Prizes \$6.50 / Lineage \$7.50 / Expense \$3.00
- All Events and Scratch Events
 - 1. \$5.00 per bowler, per event.
 - 2. Prizes \$4.50 / Expense \$.50

TOURNAMENT PLAY

- All bowlers must report to the tournament office prior to their scheduled bowling time
- · Lanes will be assigned by the tournament director.
- All games of each event will be bowled on the same pair of lanes.
- The order in which the bowlers are listed on the entry form will be the official bowling order. No changing of bowlers between team and doubles sets or rearranging of the bowling order is allowed.
- Bowler(s) arriving late will be allowed to bowl. Late bowlers will receive zero in any frames missed. Scoring will start in the next frame that the late bowler(s) is up to
- · Substitutes will be allowed. All substitutions must be reported to the tournament office prior to the start of practice.
- · Substitutes during an event will receive handicap based on the original or the substitutes average, whichever is higher.
- In the event of a machine breakdown, the tournament office will move bowlers to another pair of lanes if available. If no pair is available, the bowlers must wait until the next squad time that lanes are available. If arrangements cannot be made to finish the series, refunds will be given only for that event.
- Premature termination of the tournament brought on by war, national emergency, or other reasons beyond the control of the Madison USBC Bowling Association will cause the foregoing prize list to be prorated based on the number of entrants in each event at the time of termination.

PRIZES

Prize fees will be returned 100% in prizes with one prize for at least every five entries into each event, including optional events.

AUTHORITY

- Decisions of the tournament committee are final.
- Appeals may be made, in writing, to the rules department of the United States Bowling Congress with a copy to the local association.
- Appeals must be submitted prior to the distribution of prizes.
