Rules

ELIGIBILITY AND PARTICIPATION

- All youth participants in qualifying events must have a current USBC membership prior to participating.
- Qualifiers must provide the following information to the BCAW by March 30, 2018:
 1. Completed Average Verification Form
 2. Payment for each advancing team with report form filled out and signed by the tournament director.
- This is a doubles team competition. Each team must be comprised of two players; consisting of one 2017-18 USBC youth member whose birthdate must be 8/1/1997 or later and one adult (age 18+ and not bowling in a youth league). There is no family relationship requirement to participate in this event.
- An adult may bowl with more than one youth bowler on a squad, but no more than three youth bowlers. The adult and youth teams must bowl concurrently on the same pair of lanes.
- Qualifying events will utilize the following divisions:
 1. One adult / One U10 youth
 2. One adult / One U15 youth
 3. One adult / One U20 youth
- All Boys and Girls will compete in the same divisions.
- Birthdates for each division are as follows:
 1. U10 = 08/01/07 to present
 2. U15 = 08/01/02 to 07/31/07
 3. U20 = 08/01/97 to 07/31/02
 4. Adult = 07/31/99 or earlier and not bowling in a youth league.

AVERAGES

- Bowler will use their highest current standard league season averages.
- If no current season average, bowlers will use highest 2016-17 average.
- If no average, men will be assigned 180, women 150.
- Sport or Challenge league averages will be adjusted using the USBC Sport and/or Challenge conversion charts
- Bowlers with no average will bowl scratch.

FORMAT

- Handicap is the total of 100% of 220 per bowler.
- Entrants bowl three games on one pair of lanes.
- The three division winners will earn a paid entry to the Wisconsin State Finals Tournament.
- One out of four entries will qualify to enter the Wisconsin State Finals Tournament.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

- Scholarships will be awarded to the top finishers in each division, based on entries.
- Scholarships will be awarded to a minimum of one out of ten bowlers.
- Division winners will receive a championship award.
- The overall champion, based on pins over average, will earn Madison Area USBC Challenge Coins.

GENERAL

- No smoking, alcohol, tobacco products, electronic smoking devices, or foul language will be permitted in the bowling area during any level of competition.
- Participation in any tournament sponsored, conducted or held by or on behalf of BCAW is open, upon the same terms and conditions, to all bowlers who do, or have done, any league, tournament, advertised exhibition or any other type of bowling
 - (a) in a BPAA member establishment
 - (b) in a non-BPAA member establishment.
- Any owner or employee of any bowling establishment may participate if otherwise eligible.
- All matters not covered by these Rules and Regulations will be determined by the BCAW Staff. All decisions will be final.
