2022-2023 Women's Championships

GENERAL

- · The Madison Area USBC Women's Championship is USBC Certified.
- · All USBC rules not specified in this document are in effect.
- · Courtesy to other bowlers is expected and will be enforced. Loud, rude, or unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated.
- · Unofficial tournament standings, official tournament rules, and final prize lists will be available on the Madison Area USBC website.

ELIGIBILITY

- The tournament is open to all certified women members of the USBC and the Madison Area USBC in the current season.
- Madison Area USBC members who are also eligible for another association tournament must have bowled a minimum of six games in a Madison Area USBC certified league in the current season.
- · Participation in the team event is unlimited, but no more than two players on any four person team may cash together more than once.
- · Participation in minor events is limited to one time per bowler.
- Entry into the minor events requires participation in both doubles and singles.
- · No more than two Professional Women Bowlers Association members of any classification may participate on any team or doubles team.

ENTRY

- Entries for each squad close the Wednesday prior to the scheduled sauad date.
- · The tournament may be extended if necessary.
- · A \$40.00 non-refundable deposit is required with each entry. Deposits refunded only if none of the requested squads are available.
- · Team, Doubles, and Singles: \$25.00 per bowler, per event.
- · Prizes \$9 / Lineage \$12 / Expense \$4
- \cdot All Events: \$5.00 per bowler. Prizes \$4.50 / Expense \$.50

AVERAGES

- · USBC Rule 319a is modified for this tournament.
- · The tournament director will assign bowler averages.
- · Bowlers will use their 2021-22 composite average of all USBC standard leagues, including leagues with less than 21 games bowled or, if none,
- · 2020-21 composite average of all USBC standard leagues, including leagues with less than 21 games bowled or, if none,
- · Current season single league average of 21 games.
- \cdot Tournament director may assign an average above the minimum of zero.
- · USBC Rule 319d is waived.

TEAM DIVISIONS

- \cdot Division 1 Team averages 680 and above.
- \cdot Division 2 Team averages 679 and below.

DOUBLES DIVISIONS

- \cdot Division 1 Team averages 340 and above
- · Division 2 Team averages 339 and below

SINGLES and ALL EVENTS DIVISIONS

- · Division 1 Individual averages 170 and above
- \cdot Division 2 Individual averages 169 and below

HANDICAP

- · Division 1 Team handicap is 100% to 880
- · Division 2 Team handicap is 100% to 680
- · Division 1 Doubles handicap is 100% to 440
- \cdot Division 2 Doubles handicap is 100% to 340 $\,$
- \cdot Division 1 Singles and All Events handicap is 100% to 220
- · Division 2 Singles and All Events handicap is 100% to 170

PRIZES

· Prize fees will be returned 100% in prizes with one prize for at least every five entries into each event, including optional events.

TITLES AND CHAMPIONSHIPS

- · The highest overall scratch scores bowled in singles, doubles, team, and all-events earn Madison Area USBC Tournament Titles.
- The highest division scores with handicap bowled in singles, doubles, team, and all-events earn Madison Area USBC Tournament Championships.

OPTIONAL EVENTS

- \cdot The first score bowled in team event will count toward the All Events total.
- · Replacements for All Events must be made before either the original or replacement entrant has bowled in any event in the tournament.
- Any All Events score is given championship consideration, however only a paid optional All Events entry will qualify a bowler for cash prizes.
- · No refunds given for any All Events entries.

TOURNAMENT PLAY

- All bowlers must report to the tournament office prior to their scheduled bowling time to check in.
- · Lanes will be assigned by the tournament director.
- · Official scorers will be provided by the Madison Area USBC.
- · All games of each event will be bowled on the same pair of lanes.
- The order in which the bowlers are listed on the entry form will be the
 official bowling order. No changing of bowlers between team and
 doubles sets or rearranging of the bowling order is allowed.
- · Bowler(s) arriving late will be allowed to bowl. Late bowlers will receive zero in any frames missed. Scoring will start in the next frame that the late bowler(s) is up to bowl.
- Substitutes will be allowed. All substitutions must be reported to the tournament office prior to the start of practice.
- Substitutes during an event will receive handicap based on the original or the substitutes average, whichever is higher.
- In the event of a machine breakdown, the tournament director will move bowlers to another pair of lanes if available. If no pair is available, the bowlers must wait until the next squad time that lanes are available. If arrangements cannot be made to finish the series, refunds will be given only for that event.
- Premature termination of the tournament brought on by war, national emergency, or other reasons beyond the control of the Madison USBC Bowling Association will cause the foregoing prize list to be prorated based on the number of entrants in each event at the time of termination.

AUTHORITY

- \cdot Decisions of the tournament committee are final.
- · Appeals may be made, in writing, to the rules department of the United States Bowling Congress with a copy to the local association.
- \cdot Appeals must be submitted prior to the distribution of prizes.
