2022-2023 Youth Open Championships

GENERAL

- · The Madison Area USBC Youth Championship is USBC Certified.
- · All USBC rules not specified in this document are in effect.
- · Courtesy to other bowlers is expected and will be enforced. Loud, rude, or unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated.
- · Unofficial tournament standings, official tournament rules, and final prize lists will be available on the Madison Area USBC website.

ELIGIBILITY

- The tournament is open to all certified youth members of the USBC and the Madison Area USBC in the current season.
- Madison Area USBC youth members who are also eligible for another association tournament must have bowled a minimum of six games in a Madison Area USBC certified league in the current season.

ENTRY

- · The tournament may be extended if necessary.
- · Team: \$20 per bowler
- · Doubles: \$15 per bowler
- · Team Breakdown: Lineage \$9 / Scholarships \$8 / Expenses & Awards \$3
- · Doubles Breakdown: Lineage \$9 / Scholarships \$5 / Expenses & Awards \$1

AVERAGES

- Bowlers will use their highest 2021-22 standard league average or converted challenge league average with 21 or more games bowled, or, if none.
- · Current League Average*, with a minimum of nine games as of December 1, 2022
- · All other will bowl scratch.
- *Note: Coaches must provide league standings for average verification.

TEAM DIVISIONS & HANDICAPS

- · Class A: Team Averages 601 and higher, 100% to 920.
- · Class B: Team Averages 521 600, 100% to 600.
- · Class C: Team Averages 441 520, 100% to 520.
- · Class D: Team Averages 361 440, 100% to 440.
- \cdot Class E: Team Averages 360 and below, 100% to 360.

DOUBLES DIVISIONS & HANDICAPS

- · Class A: Team Averages 301 and higher, 100% to 460.
- \cdot Class B: Team Averages 201 300, 100% to 300.
- · Class C: Team Averages 200 or below, 100% to 200.

SINGLES DIVISIONS* & HANDICAPS

- \cdot Class A: Averages 181 and higher, 100% to 230.
- · Class B: Averages 151 180, 100% to 180.
- · Class C: Averages 121 150, 100% to 150.
- · Class D: Averages 91 120, 100% to 120.
- · Class E: Averages 61 90, 100% to 90.
- · Class F: Averages 60 and below, 100% to 60.

*Note: Singles scores are taken from first bowled Team Events series.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

- · Team event awards will be given for at least 1:10 entries per division.
- · Singles event scholarships will be awarded for at least 1:10 entries per division.
- · Doubles event scholarships will be awarded for at least 1:10 entries per division
- · Scholarships will be given out for:
 - Highest pins over average, per gender, for the tournament.
 - High individual scratch game score, per class.
 - High individual scratch series, per class.
 - A bowler can win only one scholarship for Scratch Game / Scratch Series.
 - Series will take precedence over game.
- · All tournament scholarship fees will be paid out 100%.

CHAMPIONSHIPS

• The highest scores with handicap bowled in each division of single/team and doubles, earn Madison Area USBC Tournaments Championships.

TOURNAMENT PLAY

- · All coaches must report to the tournament office 30 minutes prior to their scheduled bowling time to check in their squad.
- \cdot Lanes will be assigned by the tournament director.
- · Official scorers will be provided by the Madison Area USBC.
- · Teams and Doubles Teams can be all boys, all girls or mixed.
- · All games of each event will be bowled on the same pair of lanes.
- The order in which the bowlers are listed on the entry form will be the official bowling order. No changing of bowlers between team and doubles sets or rearranging of the bowling order is allowed.
- Bowler(s) arriving late will be allowed to bowl. Late bowlers will receive zero in any frames missed. Scoring will start in the next frame that the late bowler(s) is up to bowl.
- · Substitutes will be allowed. All substitutions must be reported by the Coaches to the tournament office prior to the start of practice.
- Substitutes during an event will receive handicap based on the original or the substitutes average, whichever is higher.
- Tournament Management reserves the right to permit an individual from the host center to substitute, when available, in emergency cases.
- In the event of a machine breakdown, the tournament director will move bowlers to another pair of lanes if available. If no pair is available, the bowlers must wait until the next squad time that lanes are available. If arrangements cannot be made to finish the series, refunds will be given only for that event.
- Premature termination of the tournament brought on by war, national emergency, or other reasons beyond the control of the Madison USBC Bowling Association will cause the foregoing prize list to be prorated based on the number of entrants in each event at the time of termination.

AUTHORITY

- · Decisions of the tournament committee are final.
- · Appeals may be made, in writing, to the rules department of the United States Bowling Congress with a copy to the local association.
- · Appeals must be submitted prior to the distribution of prizes.
